Confession and Forgiveness:

P: When God made Israel His chosen people, He set up the sacrificial system in which people would come to the temple for forgiveness and a priest would intercede for the people and offer sacrifices for their sins. One perfect sacrifice for the forgiveness of all sins. Therefore I announce unto you the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. In His stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Luke 1:26-38
